Summary of Discussion Items

1) Update from Interim-Executive Director:

- a) **CAD RFP Evaluation Process:** Interim-Executive Director Ralph Gould provided a brief summary of some of the differences in CAD Proposal prices. Gould and Young commented on CAD contractors' transitions to less expensive hardware, and some proposers having a more acute interest in the KCDA CAD project. Gould reported that KCDA Strategic Plan projected expenses will be updated after tentative selection of CAD contractor.

- b) **PSAP RFQ:** Gould recapped that after review of PSAP Proposals by the PSAP Advisory Subcommittee, which was comprised of Police Chief Mattice, Fire Chief Austin, KCEMS Director Rodriguez, Police Chief Hinton, and Fire Chief Peterson, that the Subcommittee recommended that both PSAPs which submitted a response to the RFP were qualified based upon the requirements of the RFP. Chairman Holt reported that the Executive Committee reviewed and concurred that the responses to the RFP provided by the City of Grand Rapids and the Kent County Sheriff's Department met the established criteria of the RFP. A **MOTION** was made by Senez Rodriguez to begin discussions with the Kent County Sheriff's Department and the City of Grand Rapids regarding the contracts and contract costs. The **MOTION** was supported by Sundstrom. The **MOTION** passed.

Chairman Holt appointed a three party negotiation team of Michael Young, Chief James Hinton, and Senez Rodriguez. Michael Young will serve as chair of this committee.

2) **Update from TAC:**

- a) **911 Phone System RFP:** Cpt. Young advised that the 9-1-1 Equipment RFP is ready to release. Chair Holt noted that if there were no objections the Phone RFP would be released.

3) **Misc:**

- a) Chairman Holt advised that expiring terms will need to be addressed and that the Authority had received an invoice and communication from 911 Insight which would need to be reviewed by the Executive Committee.
